BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

GRAND CHAMPION SELECT

When quality warrants, after Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex are awarded, a Select Dog (SD) and Select Bitch (SB) may be chosen from the remaining Champions (Non Regular Class winners that are Champions and Qualify for BOB are eligible) - (WD or WB are not eligible) (AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 3, Section 14, Effective 5-12-10)

AWARD OF MERIT

The Italian Greyhound Club of America, Inc. is offering Awards of Merit to enable judges, at their discretion to recognize and acknowledge deserving exhibits in Best of Breed competition, but who were not awarded Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex. The number of awards will be as follows: One Award of Merit Minium 5-9 Champions. Two Awards of Merit 10-14 Champions. Three Awards of Merit 15-19 Champions. Four Awards of Merit 20 or more Champions.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY

All dogs entered in the Bred-By Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class. Best Bred-By Exhibitor will be selected from the Bred-By-Exhibitor winners following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class are eligible to compete.

BEST VETERAN CLASS ELIGIBILITY

Best Veteran will be selected from the Veteran Class winners following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in a Veteran Class are eligible to compete.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

NOTE: Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class for Best of Breed Competition.

Veteran 7 years & under 10 years and 10 year & older (classes divided by sex)

***Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class."**

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

NOTE: As the judges' decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won any of these classes.

* **STUD DOG CLASS** - For Stud Dogs and at least two of their Get but not more than four. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record, in the Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get MUST be entered in one of the regular conformation classes or for Best of Breed Competition. No Stud Dog or his Get may be shown as a part of another unit. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed.

* **BROOD BITCH CLASS** - Same as for the Stud Dog Class except substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog" and "Produce" for "Get."
* Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

* **Brace Class** - For two Italian Greyhounds with one common owner. Entry is \$15.00 per dog and must be made using two (2) complete entry forms, one for each dog in the brace.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. Entries must reach the Show Secretary, Doris Bandoian, 1220 N. Richfield Rd., Anaheim, CA 92807-1812, by NOON (PDT), Wednesday, June 14, 2017. Fees should accompany entries. The Club and the Show Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. The Club and the Show Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agent entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
2. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The CLUB will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.
3. Exhibitors' confirmations and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the Show Secretary. Confirmations returned by the Post Office marked "Undeliverable" will be held at the Show Secretary's office. PLEASE BRING YOUR CONFIRMATIONS TO THE SHOW.
4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly in order that judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owner of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, it's owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of these clubs nor the American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 8 AM to 6 PM.
5. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging ring by completion of the breed and the show secretaries office advised at once, in the event of any discrepancy. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany the premium list. Rule books may be obtained online from the A.K.C., www.AKC.org.
7. The Club, the Show Secretary or the members or employees will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor/owner or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler/agent during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
8. No grooming tables, pens or exhibitors setups will be allowed in the aisles and all grooming must be done at least 20 ft. away from the judging ring in areas specified by the club.
9. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Event Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fees for duplicate entry.
10. Only dogs that are eligible to compete to be allowed on the grounds.
11. The Italian Greyhound Club Of America, Inc., may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
12. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
13. **Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.**
14. A recording fee of 50 cents per dog and an event service fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show. These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2.)
15. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Confirmation judging at the show.
16. All persons attending this event hereby waive any claim for damages against the Club, or its, members, in the event a motor vehicle has to be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or improperly vented conditions.
17. All vehicles parked in VIP Parking Area without VIP Pass will be ticketed and fined.
18. Parents and/or Guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.

- Ventura County Fairgrounds, the Burbank Kennel Club, Inc., the Ventura County Dog Fanciers Association and their members assume no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property during activities connected with events of this Cluster Show. Exhibitors and handlers are encouraged to secure their valuables at all times.
- THIS IS A SELF-CLEANING EVENT and clean-up equipment is provided. Any exhibitor observed failing to clean up may be subject to disciplinary action.
- Two-wheeled scooters, motorized or other, are not allowed on the Fairgrounds. NO TWO WHEEL VEHICLES, ROLLER BLADES, ROLLER SHOES (WHEELIES), SKATE BOARDS WILL BE ALLOWED. Note: Two wheel vehicles do not qualify as a disabled person's vehicle.
- Quiet time is to be maintained between 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. No generators or barking dogs are permitted during those hours.

SETUPS AND GROOMING

- OUTDOOR SETUPS are permitted only beyond 10 feet of all show rings and where they do not cause congestion or block access to the rings. Safety regulations and limited space prohibit setups in day-of-show parking lots.
- INSIDE ANACAPA AND SAN MIGUEL HALLS (judging buildings) all setups must be within areas bounded by walls and the taped line. Exercise pens are not allowed in the exhibition buildings. Blow dryers, vacuum or electrical devices of any kind are not allowed to be used in these buildings. Dogs must be removed after showing, and dogs must not be left overnight. Roping off, mats on the ground, or saving space in the exhibition buildings is strictly prohibited.
- RESERVED GROOMING AREAS are provided in Santa Cruz Hall where power is adequate for blowers. This building is designated solely for grooming and set-ups. It is not available for other functions such as group lunches, raffles and club meetings.
- UNRESERVED GROOMING AREAS: All unreserved grooming and day crating is provided on a first come, first served basis. An outdoor grooming tent will be provided. Roping off or saving unused space in the unreserved grooming area and/or buildings by any means is strictly prohibited. Each exhibitor is responsible for clean-up in and around their set-up.
- The Cluster Committee reserves the right to require the stacking of crates and any other remedies it may deem necessary for space in non-reserved areas on a case-by-case basis at their discretion. We encourage exhibitors to efficiently use their space to allow everyone the opportunity to have space.
- A DOG BATHING AREA is provided by the Seaside Spectacular Cluster and is located outside (Southwest side) Santa Cruz Hall. Tubs are provided and must not be moved from this area due to runoff. Please use water shut-offs after bathing your dog. No bathing of dogs will be allowed in any other area. Exhibitors found bathing their dogs in other areas will be subject to an event show hearing. FAILURE TO COMPLY IMMEDIATELY WITH ANY DIRECTION OF THE EVENT COMMITTEE OR ITS DESIGNEES MAY RESULT IN AN EVENT COMMITTEE HEARING AND REVOCATION OF AN INDIVIDUAL'S RIGHT TO REMAIN ON THE GROUNDS AND REMOVAL OF EQUIPMENT MAY RESULT.
